Parish Hall/Gymnasium Renovation

The *Catholic Foundation* has given our parish a **matching challenge grant of \$25,000** for the **Parish Hall/Gymnasium**. To date we have raised **\$28,889.97**. The opportunity of actually being able to increase our goal by another **\$50,000** with the matching grant program we could quickly be at our half way mark of **\$75,000** for the first phase of the floor renovation to begin. **65 years ago** renovations were made for our generation. It is our turn to pay for the upkeep of our **Parish Hall/Gymnasium**. It is very much like your own **home**, it needs loving care, maintenance, time and funds to keep it looking good and maintained.

FOOD PANTRY**

Neighbor Outreach of Colorado will hold a Mobile Food Pantry starting at 3pm, Thursday, April 16th, at Holy Cross Catholic Church, Thornton. Anyone needing food assistance should bring a box or bags to carry food. No pre-sign-up necessary. Food will be handed out on a first-come, first-served basis (one distribution per family).
