Assumption Catholic Parish

Baptism Requirements

- Family must be contributing registered members of our parish for a minimum of 6 months.
Purpose: As parents and godparents you are promising to raise your child in our Catholic faith and in our Catholic Community.
- At least one godparent needs to prove that they are in good standing with a parish.
Purpose: The godparent you have chosen to guide your child in their faith is an active member in their parish they.
- Baptism of the child should be scheduled at least one month in advance.
Purpose: This insures availability of the celebrant and preparation time for the parents and godparents.
- Baptism preparation class is needed.
Purpose: Those who are promising to baptize a child need to be prepared. Class is not necessary for godparents who have attended preparation class within the past 5 years.
- Stipend is optional.
Purpose: It is proper to offer a stipend to the celebrant performing the baptism. The amount is up to the family's discretion.
