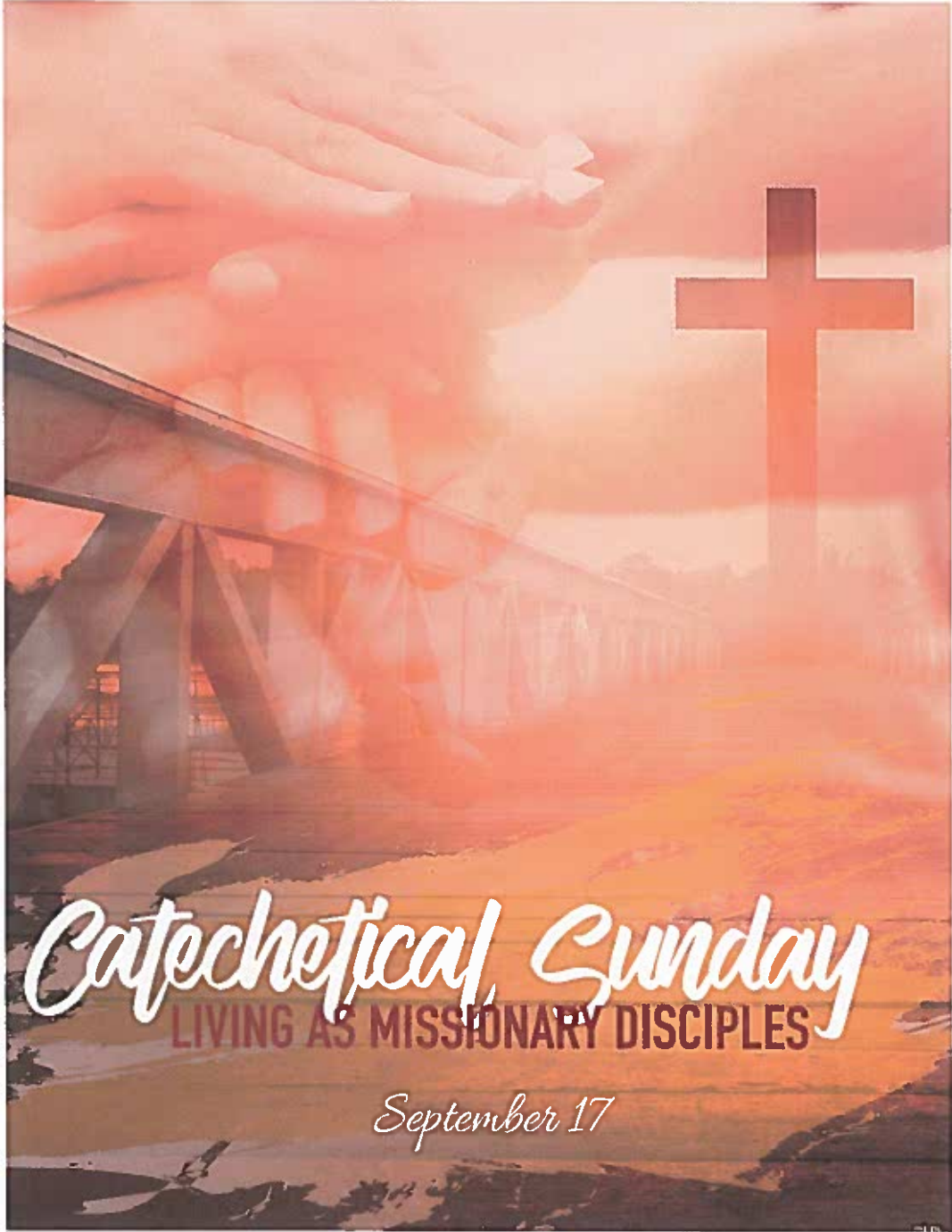

Prayer for Catechetical Sunday

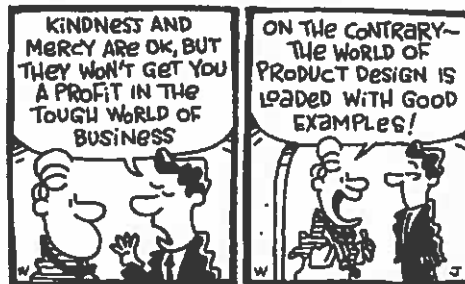
Dear Lord Jesus,
