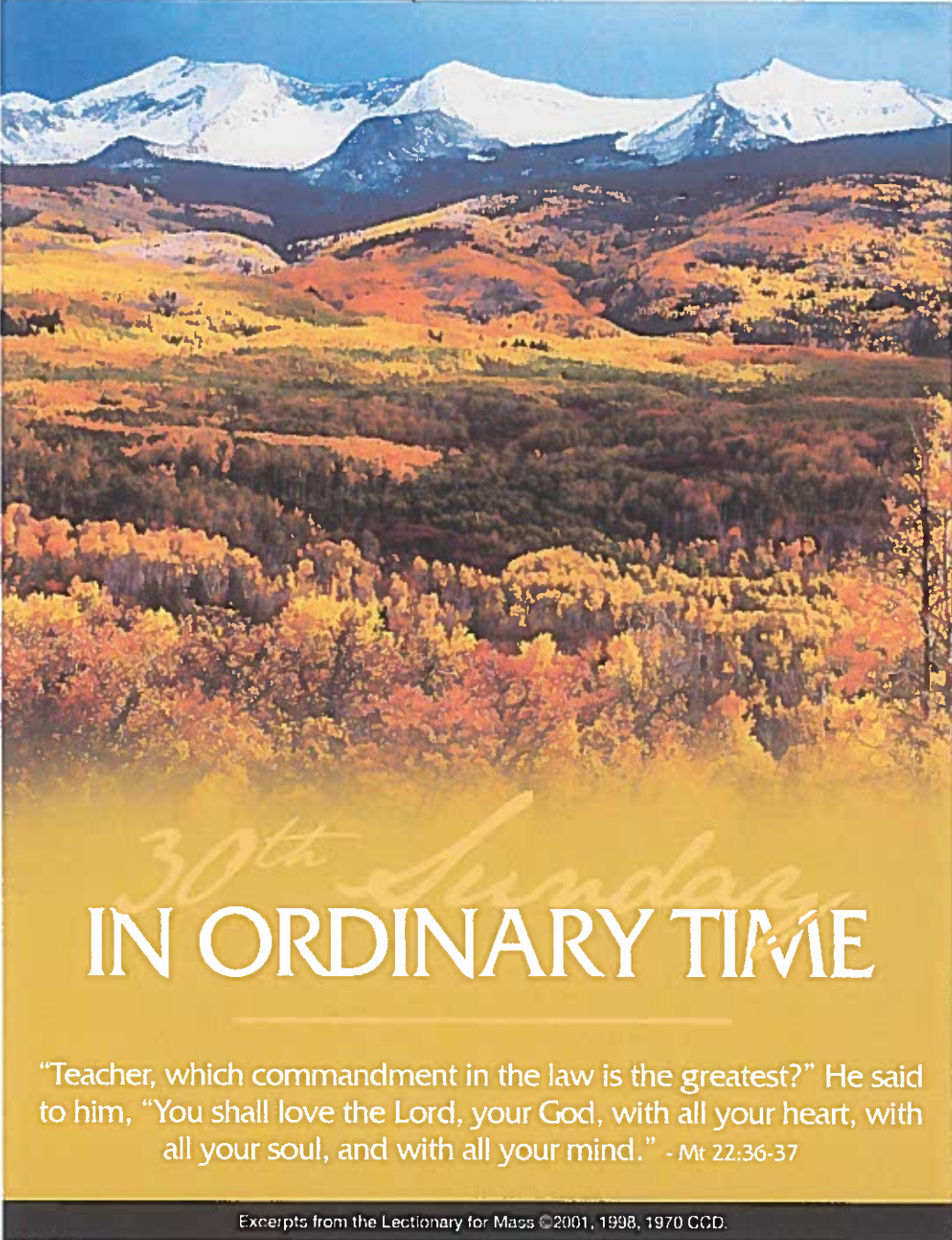

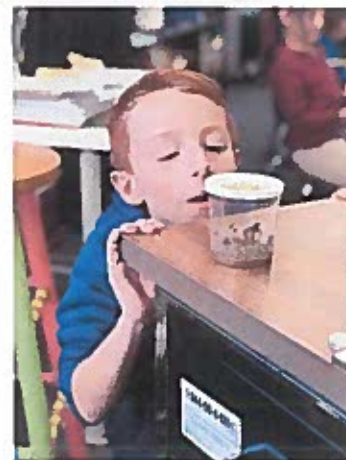
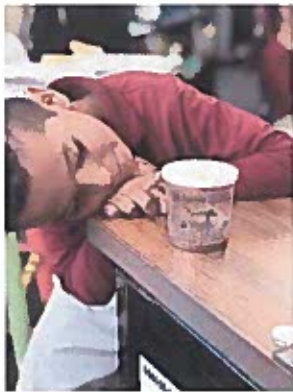

Sacraments

Baptism: Parents are asked to call our Parish Office to discuss baptizing your child at least one month prior to the preferred baptism date. Both parents and godparents are required to attend a baptism preparation class. At least one family member is to be an active, registered member of our parish for at least the last six months.

Marriage: Couples are asked to arrange a proposed marriage date with our priest **one year in advance**. At least one of the engaged couple must be an active, registered member of our parish for at least the last six months.

Reconciliation: Confessions are heard on Saturdays at 4:00 pm. Individual confessions are heard by appointment made in advance with the priest.

Anointing of the Sick: The Healing Sacrament is available following the 5:00 pm mass on the first Saturday of the month. Please notify our Parish Office to schedule a visit for those who are homebound or in the hospital.
